Wrestlers prepare for 15th straight SLT NEWS RELEASE NOVEMBER 1, 2006

The Wadsworth wrestling program produced yet another Wrestling State Champ. Senior Dave Crowley kept the Wadsworth's elite tradition going by defeating his opponent in the State Final's match last March. Dave Crowley wrestled to season record of 48-6 record and earned Most Valuable Wrestler honors selected by the Medina County Gazette.

This accomplishment helped lead the Grizzlies to an exciting team finish for the 2005-06 season. They finished 15-3 in dual matches, qualified five individuals and placed two, finishing District Runners- up and 7th place overall at the State Tournament.

Individually, Dave Crowley and Derek Foore wrestled in the State Championship match. Foore losing hard fought decision 3-1 while Jeff Rager Jordan Bryson and Dru Jones wrestled admirably but failed to place. For the 12th year in a row, Wadsworth wrestling has produced a finalist or two, vying or winning an individual State Championship.

Foore is back along with State qualifer Dru Jones and 5 District qualifers. Now the coaches and the rest of the 2006-07 team are ready to begin their quest to 15 peat and continue the dominance in the Suburban League, as well as, take a more than the record six to the State Tournament in the 16,000 seat Schottenstein Center in Columbus.

After completing one of the toughest schedules in team history and winning its 14 consecutive Suburban League championships and placing 11 out of top 13 finishes at the State Tournament, area teams may wonder if the Grizzlies will have anything left in the year 2006. The 2006-07 season will soon test the Grizzlies who have worked hard in the off season, trying to earn the privilege to carry on the great tradition set by past teams. This year's Grizzlies will try to fend off perennial powers and Co-champs Barberton, Highland and Green . Last year the Grizzlies won the League and also won the League Tournament and its 14th consecutive title, posting 7 champions with 3 returning : Joey Dean, Derek Foore, and Dru Jones.

The nucleus of the 2006-07 team has worked extremely hard in the off-season, with individual wrestlers posting more than 200 total hours of lifting weight, wrestling at open mats on Thursday night, and attending summer camps especially Jeff Jordan's team camp, and competing nationally at Cadet and Junior National Tournaments in Fargo, North Dakota.

The 2006 team is led by **Seniors:** Nate Budney, Derek Foore, and Matt Snodgrass; along with returning **Letterwinners:** Danny Foore, Alex Gray, Marc Snodgrass, Joey Dean, Logan Ramsey, and Dru Jones, **Coaches:** Head Coach John Gramuglia, Assistants: Mike Kallai, Larry Kaufman, and Bobby Jones, Volunteers: Jason Friedt, Josh Hendricks, Gary Skoch, and Bart Randolph. **Team Doctor**: Dr. Papas, **Team Trainer**: Ron Burnette

The future looks promising with one of the strongest 9th grade team ever. As eighth graders, they won the one division Junior High Team State Championship. They are determined group with a great deal of potential. In fact, some freshmen will see varsity action. This is the eleventh 9th grade class with Youth League experience at Firestone High School, and the coaches have indeed noticed the difference.

Over 50 enthusiastic 7th and 8th graders have turned out for the Central Middle School. They are coached by Matt Shiarla, assistant coach Kip Shipley and second year volunteer coach Matt Hulme. All three coaches continue to do a great job molding and developing young talent that feed the high school. They have won several tournaments over the past years and have developed a winning attitude and a very strong work ethic.

Our Youth Program has over 100 members and a strong coaching nucleus headed again by Todd Baughman. Kathy Wegner remains our treasurer and will help organize and develop the inner workings of the program. Team Manager is Linda Bosley. The overall program continues to grow with over 75 plus participants for only their 17th year in the Firestone League. Last year they finished 1st in their Division and 2nd in the State tournament, qualified eleven to the Youth State Tournament with 8 State Placers which included State Champions: Kagan Squire and Nick Tavenelo, 3rd place: Aaron Warstler, 4th place: Jordan Schleigh, 5th place Dustin Grier, and 6th place: Clayton Brandenburg, Cody Gordon, and Zach Srock

The entire family of coaches are working hard in order to dominate the Suburban League and this area. It is also our goal to continue the tradition of placing wrestlers at the State Tournament and winning another ultimate wrestling honor, a State Championship.
