Wrestlers prepare for 16th straight SLT NEWS RELEASE NOVEMBER 1, 2007

The Wadsworth wrestling program produced yet another Wrestling State Champ. Freshman Brad Squire kept the Wadsworth's elite tradition going by defeating his opponent in the State Finals match last March. Brad Squire wrestled to season record of 34-0 record and Wadsworth's first freshman State Champion.

This accomplishment helped lead the Grizzlies to an exciting team finish for the 2006-07 season. They finished 14-2 in dual matches, qualified four individuals to the State, finishing District Runners- up and 4th place overall at the State Tournament, earning yet another Banner for the West Gym.

Individually, Brad Squire and Derek Foore wrestled in the State Championship match. Foore losing hard fought decision 3-1 while Danny Foore placed 4th and Ben Buzzelli wrestled admirably but failed to place. For the 13th year in a row, Wadsworth wrestling has produced a finalist or two, vying or winning an individual State Championship.

This year Squire and Danny Foore are back along with State qualifier Ben Buzzelli and five District qualifiers. Now the coaches and the rest of the 2007-08 team are ready to begin their quest to 16 peat and continue the dominance in the Suburban League, as well as, take a more than the record six to the State Tournament in the 16,000 seat Schottenstein Center in Columbus.

After completing one of the toughest schedules in team history and winning its 15 consecutive Suburban League championships and placing 12 out of top 14 finishes at the State Tournament, area teams may wonder if the Grizzlies will have anything left in the year 2007. The 2007-08 season will soon test the Grizzlies who have worked hard in the off season, trying to earn the privilege to carry on the great tradition set by past teams. This year's Grizzlies will try to fend off perennial powers Barberton, Highland and Green . Last year the Grizzlies won the League and also won the League Tournament and its 15th consecutive title, posting 7 champions with 4 returning : Danny Foore, Brad Squire, Josh Otanicar, and Ben Buzzelli

The nucleus of the 2007-08 team has worked extremely hard in the off-season, with individual wrestlers posting more than 200 total hours of lifting weight, wrestling at open mats on Thursday night, and attending summer camps especially Erik Burnette's team camp, and competing nationally at Cadet and Junior National Tournaments in Fargo, North Dakota and the Disney Duals in Orlando, Florida

The future looks promising with one of the strongest 9th grade team ever. As eighth graders, they placed second in the one division Junior High Team State Championship. They are determined group with a great deal of potential. In fact, some freshmen will see varsity action. This is the twelfth 9th grade class with Youth League experience at Firestone High School, and the coaches have indeed noticed the difference.

Over 50 enthusiastic 7th and 8th graders have turned out for the Central Middle School. They are coached by Matt Shiarla, assistant coach Kip Shipley and first year volunteer coach Brandon Cobb. All three coaches continue to do a great job molding and developing young talent that feed the high school. They have won several tournaments over the past years and have developed a winning attitude and a very strong work ethic.

Our Youth Program has over 100 members and a strong coaching nucleus headed again by Todd Baughman. Kathy Wegner remains our treasurer and will help organize and develop the inner workings of the program. Team Manager is Linda Bosley. The overall program continues to grow with over 75 plus participants for only their 18th year in the Firestone League. Last year they finished 1st in their Division and 7th in the State tournament, qualified to the Youth State Tournament with 6 State Qualifiers: Collin Tompkins, Noah Baughman, Mathias Zollinger, Clayton Brandenburg, Vince Scarberry, and Zack Srock which included Youth State Champions: Vince Scarberry and 3rd place:Clayton Brandenburg

The entire family of coaches are working hard in order to dominate the Suburban League and this area. It is also our goal to continue the tradition of placing wrestlers at the State Tournament and winning another ultimate wrestling honor, a State Championship.
