Face your fears, works hard and achieve your goals. Don't let failure hinder what lies ahead. Believe in yourself and work hard and you'll find the true meaning of success.


Don't let obstacles control your ability to be successful in everything you do. Take the risk and face the fears that hinder you from doing the best you can. This is where you will find true success.


















#### GRIZZLY SCHOTT RECAP:
