The Spartan Club has announced its Hall of Fame induction class of 2014 at Case Western Reserve University. Six former student-athletes, including two wrestlers will be enshrined at the annual Spartan Club banquet on Friday, April 25. Former Wadsworth wrestler ZACHARY KALLAI is one of the new inductees.



### ZACHARY KALLAI

Zak Kallai is the only four-time wrestling All-American in school history. Fourth on the program's all-time wins list with 126, Kallai finished eighth in the nation at 149 pounds during both his freshman and sophomore seasons. The Wadsworth, Ohio native then placed fifth in 2003 and sixth in 2004. Kallai was a two-time Arthur P. Leary Award winner in 2002 and 2003 as well as the Dr. David Hutter Male Athlete of the Year in 2004. Kallai won two University Athletic Association Championships and was one of the finest grapplers to ever suit up for legendary Head Coach Bob Del Rosa. Kallai graduated in 2005 with a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering, and he was inducted into the National Wrestling Coaches Association Division III Hall of Fame in 2011.

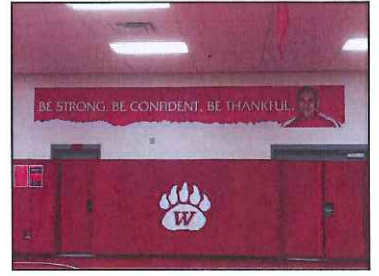
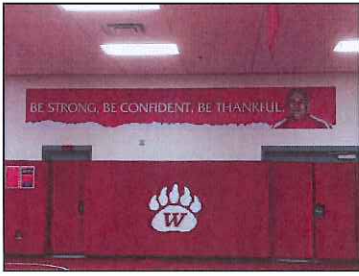
## ENERGY TAKERS: Wrestlers who need to be motivated
